 3. Provide activities focused on youth who are newcomers to Canada for a positive life experience.
 4. Provide youth leadership and mentoring training opportunities for the younger kids.
 5. Organize children/youth summer camp/drop-off activities.
 6. Organize neighbourhood and community barbeque to introduce attendees to the community support the church provides.
 7. Plan and lead Sunday School
 8. Plan and lead week-long Youth Leadership training (building leaders)
